STATEMENT REQUIRED BY VIRGINIA LAW [Code § 3.1-796.96(2)] A Virginia law went into effect on July 1, 2003 requiring all "home-based rescues," which would include BARK (Bandit's Adoption & Rescue of K-9s) within its definition, to obtain signed statements from anyone adopting from, volunteering with, or connected to us in any capacity that the individual "has never been convicted of animal neglect, abandonment, or cruelty."
